Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur



Spaces for disabled congregants

There are limited spaces available to Blue Badge holders in the synagogue car park. It would be appreciated if these could be left for those congregants who cannot be dropped off i.e. those who are the only occupant or cannot walk for 50 yards/46 metres (length of driveway).

Park and ride

1st Day Rosh Hashanah – Monday 10th September

Yom Kippur – Wednesday 19th September

Easy Park & Ride from Sainsbury's car park

- Minibus service directly to the synagogue door, start and end one hour before & after the services
- Parking in Sainsbury's has been agreed for **30 cars only**.
- The area to be used is a separate space, located just as you enter the car park, immediately on the right. This is accessible by entering the car park, then drive round, as if leaving, and it is on the left to the side of Poundstretchers. This space holds 20 vehicles so the additional 10 cars permitted need to park as near to this area as possible.
- Please do not park anywhere else in the car park.

Important Park and Ride information for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur

For those using the park and ride facility from Sainsbury's, please note that they now have cameras and are operating 3 hour maximum free parking. The store has kindly offered to override this as long as you register your name and vehicle registration with the store information desk. If you do not register and you exceed the 3 hours, you may be fined.

Park and walk

1st Day Rosh Hashanah – Monday 10th September, Yom Kippur – Wednesday 19th September ONLY

Redbridge Council have generously lifted the weekday parking restrictions from the Eastern Avenue to the junction of Acorn Court **only - after the double red lines**.

Redbridge Council have advised that any vehicles seen parking and obstructing someone's driveway, parking opposite a T-junction or parking within 10 metres of a junction (as per the Highway Code) may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice. They will also need to respond to any complaints received from residents concerning obstructions

Drop and Ride/Walk

Drop off at synagogue door, drive to Sainsbury's Car Park and ride or walk back.
