We need to find one very special person who is both brave and kind enough to want to donate a kidney. This person would, literally, be giving the Gift of Life.

All About Joe

Let us tell you a little about "Joe", the person who would receive the donated kidney. First of all, Joe is not his real name. We have to protect his confidentiality as he has special needs. He is a very gentle and vulnerable person with autistic tendencies. Joe has several talents. He is artistic and loves music. He also has great charm and an excellent sense of humour.

Joe's Current Options are...

- To wait a number of years for a deceased person's kidney (the risk of this is that this kidney may have a lesser lifespan, making further transplants necessary down the line)

- To undergo dialysis. This would involve travelling to hospital three days a week and being attached to a machine for four to five hours a time until a kidney may become available.

The Search is On!

Anyone would find this choice challenging but, because of Joe's autism, both of these options could cause further problems and greater distress.

We have been told that a living donor's kidney has potentially a much greater lifespan than that of a deceased person. That is the reason for this Just For Joe appeal. We have heard that, amazingly, there are people somewhere out there who really do want to help others in this way and now we are seeking that special someone who can save Joe's life. Could you be that person?
